Historically, we relied on teachers to trust the SLP and send kids to speech to "fix" them. Today, we know that quality service requires collaboration. Find out what many districts already know - times have changed, and so has speech therapy.

Our "Hello There" model puts kids first through a blend of on-site and off-site service. Your SLP partnership will include monthly in-person visits and ongoing video and phone consultation - directing your speech program, training your aide, and developing a wealth of institutional knowledge. At all times, SLPs are responsible for lesson plans, paperwork, SPED/IEP meetings, report writing, service to students and consultation. Because wherever we are, we're there for you and your students.

When On-Site, your SLP may:

- Provide direct service
- Spend time in gen ed classrooms
- Observe students and teaching styles
- Model therapy techniques
- Supervise and guide the Speech Aide
- Conduct evaluations
- Implement modifications/adaptations
- Program augmentative devices

AND

When Off-Site, your SLP will:

- Supervise and guide the Speech Aide online
- Provide direct service to students as needed online
- Update progress notes
- Develop IEPs
- Review data
- Collaborate with teachers, parents, and aides
